# Dartmouth

## Berthing (see map below)

- On arrival, call **Dartnav on ch11** (07:30-23:00) and tell them you are with the regatta.
- For arrivals between 23:00 and 07:30, use the anchorage temporarily.
- Your berth for the nights of 7-9th July is already paid for via your entry fee (berthing before or after 7-9th July will be chargeable by the Harbour Authority).
- A water taxi (ch69) runs 08:00-22:30, free of charge for boats not on walk-ashore pontoons.
- For shore-to-shore transport (Dartmouth-Kingswear-Dartmouth), the lower ferry runs 07:10-22:45, free of charge to competitors with CCR wristbands.\*
- Darthaven, Dart Marina and Noss-on-Dart commercial marinas are available but are not covered by your entry fee.

\* For Tuesday only, codeword "BruceSpeedwell" can be used in place of wristbands on the lower ferry

## Fuel

- Fuel Barge (mid-river) 08:30-18:00.

## Water

- Town Quay, DA & DYC pontoons & the waste pontoon (mid-river).

## Electricity

- Town Quay only.

## Waste

- Waste pontoon (mid-river)
- Follow local regulations when disposing of food waste that has been brought in from abroad.

## Toilets & showers

- Public facility opposite Green Pontoon 09:00-17:00 (coin operated).
- RDYC 11:00-21:00 and DYC 11:30-22:00 (charge payable at DYC).

## Connections

- Bus and taxi to Totnes rail station.
- Exeter airport 1 hour and Bristol airport 2 hours.
- Limited parking in Dartmouth. Park & Ride service from just outside the town with a regular shuttle bus 08:00-19:00, cost £10 per day.

# St Peter Port

## Berthing

- On arrival, call **St Peter Port Marina** on ch80 and tell them you are with the regatta.
- Your berth for the night of 11th July is already paid for via your entry fee.
- Berthing before or after 11th July will be chargeable by the Harbour Authority.
- Berths will be allocated on the outer walk-ashore pontoons outside Victoria Harbour.
- You will be required to raft-up; have fenders ready on both sides.
- One pontoon (Quarantine) is not walk-ashore (normally used when pets are onboard) and may require a dinghy.

## Fuel

- In front of the Boatworks Chandlery south end of the "Pool" 08:00-17:00. Note: access may be tidally restricted.

## Water

- On all Pontoons except the "Quarantine" pontoon.

## Electricity

- Inner harbour only.

## Waste

- Bins near all gangways in Victoria Marina.

## Toilets & showers

- On both sides of Victoria Harbour.

## Connections

- Fast ferry to Poole & regular flights to UK airports.
- Ferry to Jersey and onward connection to St Malo.

## Repairs & chandlery

- Boatworks (+44 1481 726071) on the Castle Emplacement can assist with most repairs including engine and electrical.

- Good shopping with M&S a short walk along Victoria Dock.

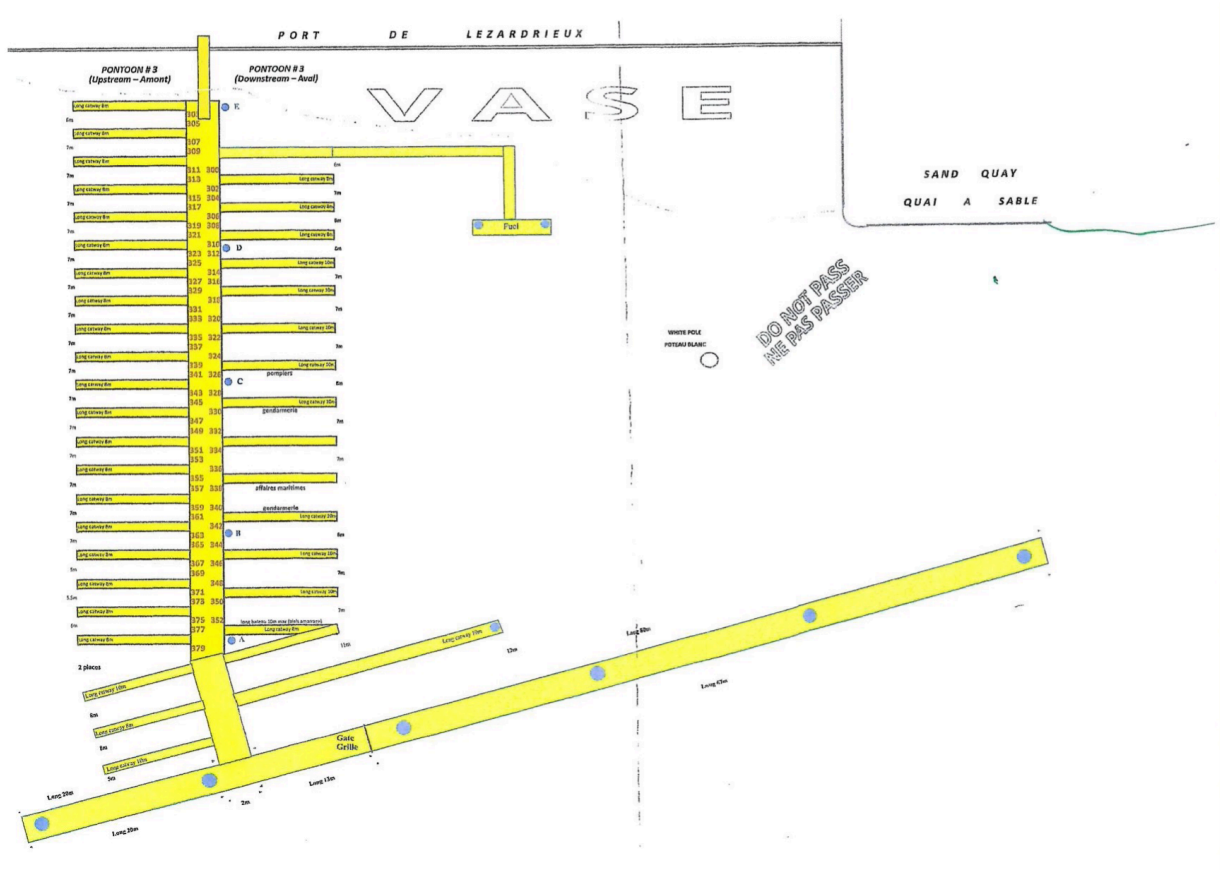
## Restaurants

- Waste sorting area (tri-bennes) located at the harbour master's pontoon.

- On the Rue de la Port and Rue du 8 Mai.

# Paimpol

## Berthing

- Berthing will be in the inner harbour (all walk-ashore).
- The lock is generally free-flow from HW-1hr to HW
- You will be directed to a specific place within the harbour by marina staff assisted by local Paimpol CCR volunteers.
- Please adhere to the entry procedure that you will be given in Lezardrieux; timing is critical to get 100 boats through the lock gates during free-flow.

## Fuel

- In front of the Maison des Plaisanciers in Bassin 2 during working hours.

## Water

- On all pontoons.

## Electricity

- On all pontoons.

## Waste

- Designated bins around the harbour for sorted waste.

## Toilets & showers

- In the Capitainerie (Maison Des Plaisanciers)..

## Connections

- Rail: via Guingamp to either Roscoff (via Morlaix) then a short bus ride to Roscoff ferry terminal) or St Malo via Rennes: [www.sncf-connect.com/en-en/](http://www.sncf-connect.com/en-en/).
- It is possible to get to St Malo early enough by train to connect with the morning ferry starting from Guingamp on a weekday and on Saturday but you will need to get a taxi to Guingamp from Paimpol which is about 30km away to catch the first train (departs approx. 6.47am from Guingamp).
- Taxi: prices for a firm in Paimpol with an 8 seater taxi are comparable to rail if full both ways; quicker too. Paimpol to St Malo is about 2 hours and costs a minimum of about €45pp. Paimpol to Roscoff is also 2 hours and costs a minimum of about €40pp. Both prices assume taxis are full both ways. We have a volunteer coordinating taxis to try to fill them: Bill Hogg [billhogg.z35@gmail.com](mailto:billhogg.z35@gmail.com).
- Nearest airport is Rennes with flights to the UK. Brest has a direct flight to Birmingham.

## Repairs & chandlery

- Good facilities east of the harbour (Quai de Kernoa - see map) with well stocked chandlery and repair facilities.
